General Information

- Convention runs Monday Aug 19th Thurs Aug 22nd
 - Plan on Sunday, Aug 18th arrival; Fri, Aug 23rd departure (typical travel plan for delegates, plan travel times accordingly)
 - Traditionally a welcome party is hosted for delegations Sunday evening
- **Delegation Hotel:** Sheraton Grand Chicago Riverwalk (301 E North Water St)
 - Hotel check-in: 4PM; Check out: 12PM; Parking \$68/night
 - Delegation Breakfast: Sheraton IV Ballroom (Mon-Thurs, 8-10AM)
 - You must pick up YOUR OWN credential DAILY
- Caucus/Committee meeting place: McCormick Place (2301 S Martin Luther King Dr)
- Evening Program: United Center (1901 W Madison St)
- There will be free shuttles running between the hotel, McCormick PI, and United Center.
 - Only credentialed individuals will be able to use the shuttles

Breakfast

- Each day will begin with a breakfast hosted by WisDems, running from 8:00AM-10:00AM CST
 - Sheraton IV Ballroom
- Important information and updates from Chair Wikler for the day
- Guest speakers, raffles, mingling!
- Raffle for daily guest passes
- Breakfast will be where delegates pick up their credentials each morning. You must be at breakfast by 9:55AM to pick up your credentials for the day. If you do not pick up your credentials, they will be forfeited for that day.

Daily Caucuses & Training Sessions

- Caucuses will meet twice during the week (Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday)
 - WisDems will highlight schedule of trainings for that day at breakfast
- Guests are allowed to attend the caucuses & training sessions
- The caucus space will have places to purchase lunch, as well as a number of other vendors
- Shuttles run from the McCormick Center directly to the United Center
 - Only credentialed individuals will be permitted on shuttles

Convention Programming

- The United Center will open each day at 3:00PM
 - Preprogramming: ~3:00PM-6:00PM
 - Main programming ~6:00PM-10:00PM
- Convention hall fills quickly as we approach the primetime program. We advise early arrival to ensure you make it into the building!
 - Finding transportation can also be difficult as we get close the main program; only shuttles allowed in perimeter
- Concessions available for purchase
- Our delegation will have an assigned area in the convention hall
 - Alternates, committee members, and guests will sit in a separate section
- Expect programming until 10:00PM each evening

Convention Security

- Expect airport-level security through Secret Service
- List of prohibited items will be shared with you in follow up email, highlights include:
 - No pets besides service animals
 - No bags larger than 18x13x7 (standard backpack)
 - Balloons, signs, noisemakers, or generally loose flying objects
 - No umbrellas with metal tips
 - No unapproved motorized mobility devices
 - No weapons, including swiss army knives or pocket knives
 - No glass, thermal, or metal containers
 - No selfie sticks

After the Program

- Each night after the convention program ends there will be optional events hosted by state parties and groups
 - WisDems will share info as we receive it, but you may also hear directly from groups/states
 - o Follow or contact your favorite groups to hear about them (Planned Parenthood, labor, etc)
- WisDems will be hosting a concert with the Arizona Democratic Party on Monday, Aug 19th, following gavel-out of convention
 - House of Blues Chicago (329 N Dearborn St, Chicago)
 - Jimmy Eat World
 - Free to delegates + 1 guest
 - Note: you will need to find transportation directly from United Center OR take shuttle back to hotel (15 min walk from hotel)
- We encourage you to enjoy yourself, but remember that you must be at breakfast each morning to pick up your
 credentials for the day!

Highlights

- Plan on walking/standing a lot, comfy shoes!
- Must get credential each morning between 8-10AM at Sheraton IV
- Daytime activities open to guests, shuttles only for credentialed individuals
 - Evening program for credentialed individuals only
- Communication via text line with DPW Staff; reach out with questions or problems any time
- Monday Aug 19th, House of Blues Concert for WI delegation
- Make a plan for your days, including travel time between venues and activities!
